TSA HS Summer Reading Requirements:

You will have two summer reading requirements. The first requirement is the *All High School Summer Reading*, which is detailed below. The second is the summer work required for your Exhibition. Information about that will be sent to you shortly.

All High School Summer Reading

This year, the high school has chosen a list of 12 books for students to select from for their school-wide summer reading expectation. These books fall into TWO themes and we invite students to take a close look at the options:

- 1) The first theme is a "Look at Institutional Racism". Click on the link below to see a list of books from which you should have already chosen. This group of students that have chosen to read a book from this theme will meet in small groups and then gather in the larger group of people who chose books from that theme.
- 2) The second theme is "Reading for the fun of it". Click on the link below to see a list of books from which you should have already chosen. Students will meet in small groups during orientation to discuss their book as well as engage in relevant activities.
