

Fun fact! As of Friday, April 31st, there are <4 in-school weeks until Senior Presentation day.

Dear Seniors,

These are some important dates to keep in mind relative to your progress in assembling and completing your Exhibition.

The project is a time-sensitive process and a graduation requirement. What follows is a list of “Last Chance” dates for completing the elements of the project in a way to qualify you for on time graduation (separate from other requirements, like Community Service, for ex.):

Thursday, April 27th—Technology & Title Planning Forms must be in to Maria.

Thursday, May 4th — Is the last day for seniors to demonstrate to their Mentors they have a presentation-ready body of work. If this is not in the form of a well-developed (if perhaps not finalized) paper, Mentors need to see the content structure of a presentation.

If a senior cannot meet this date, Maria needs to know immediately in order to be able to finalize the presentation schedule on Friday, May 5th.

Monday, May 8th — Presentation Day (just FYI and for context)

Monday, May 15th, 3:30 — The last day for a senior to submit a final draft for assessment in time to receive a diploma at Graduation (see below).

Monday, May 22nd – Papers returned to the student by mentor

*****Friday, May 26th – Senior has turned in completed reflection to Mentor*****

A senior who does not present on time or who misses the May 15th or the May 26th deadlines should not expect a diploma in the green folder on Graduation Day (Sunday, June 18th), but will still walk and speak in the ceremony.
