ARLINGTON, Vt. — The Sharon Academy boys soccer team is having little difficulty finding the back of the net two matches into its VPA Division IV season.

Riley Eastman snapped the twine three times while Daniel Henderson and Ever Tofel struck twice each as the Phoenix rolled over Arlington, 7-2, on Friday evening. The victory came on the heels of an 8-1 rout of Randolph to open the campaign 48 hours earlier.

The Eastman-Henderson-Tofel triumvirate combined for 13 points in that win and produced another 12 against the Eagles. Eastman added three assists for a six-point evening. Henderson, Tofel and Luke Miller each had one assist. Goalie Parker Bogardus made two saves.

Tied 2-2 in the first half, Sharon scored for a one-goal halftime lead before adding four more unanswered goals in the second half.

"It was an odd game," coach Blake Fabrikant said. "We came out flat and disorganized, but thankfully our well-taken goals kept us in the game while our defense sorted things out. Our three attacking midfielders (Eastman, Henderson, Tofel) are all incredibly dynamic and skilled."

Fabrikant will be looking for better possession and composure when the Phoenix meet Mount St. Joseph on Tuesday.
